As well as the Conference theme, abstracts can focus on other topics, including, but not limited to, forgiveness and reconciliation in society, the consequences of trauma in society, communities and conflict, torture and violence in society, drug and substance abuse, HIV and AIDS, discord in families, counselling supervision and issues of personal development.

Please submit an official abstract form which will provide sufficient information to allow the presentation to be placed in the most appropriate section of the programme. The Conference Committee will review the abstracts submitted and those selected will be notified.

The deadline for submissions is 30th May, 2011.

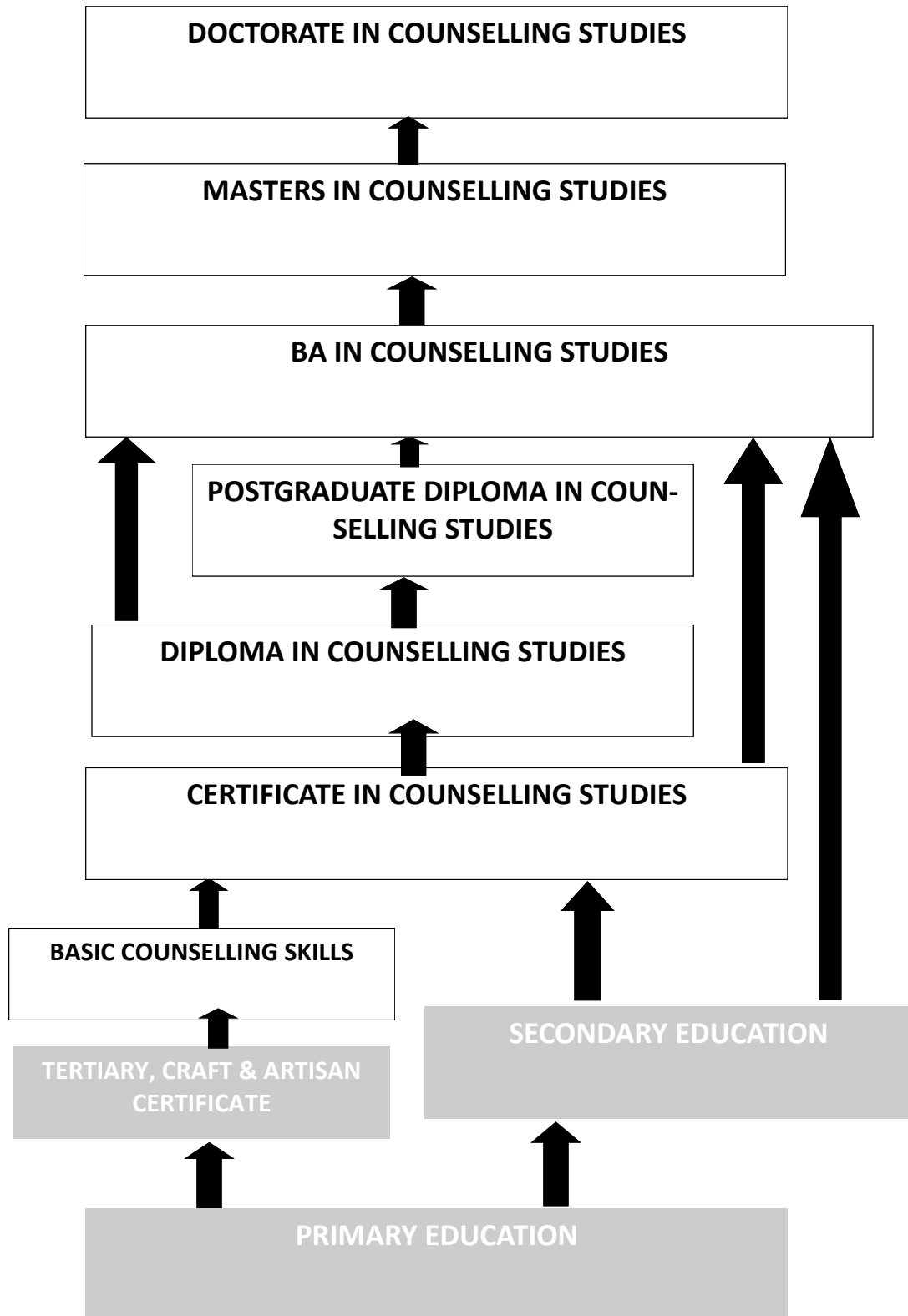
